

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED REPORTS JULY 2022 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia - September 01, 2022. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines ("AGIL" or "the Group") transported 2.3 million passengers in July 2022; a 74.5% increase when compared to July 2021. AGIL's total capacity deployment increased by 105.1%, to 3.8 billion ASKs from 1.8 billion in the same period of 2021. Total RPKs for the period increased by 125.5% to reach 3.2 billion in July 2022, from 1.4 billion in July 2021.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for July 2022 increased by 121.3% year-on-year. July 2022 RPKs increased by 151.7%, with an 86.3% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for July 2022 increased by 61.8% year-on-year, with a 61.0% increase in RPKs and a Load Factor of 81.9%.

Noteworthy Results - Cargo Segment

Cargo ATKs in July 2022 increased by 16.3% year-on-year, with a 7.5% RTKs increase as compared to July 2021 and a Load Factor of 64.7%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
