

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

REPORTS OCTOBER 2022 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – November 29, 2022. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines (“AGIL” or “the Group”) transported 2.0 million passengers in October 2022; a 38.1% increase when compared to October 2021. AGIL’s total capacity deployment increased by 94.3%, to 3.5 billion ASKs from 1.8 billion in the same period of 2021. Total RPKs for the period increased by 90.1% to reach 2.8 billion in October 2022, from 1.5 billion in October 2021.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for October 2022 increased by 119.8% year-on-year. October 2022 RPKs increased by 126.1%, with an 83.3% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for October 2022 increased by 37.0% year-on-year, with a 15.8% increase in RPKs and a Load Factor of 74.4%.

- Cargo ATKs in October 2022 increased by 20.1% year-on-year, with a 14.5% RTKs increase as compared to October 2021 and a Load Factor of 70.0%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
