

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED REPORTS FEBRUARY 2023 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – March 28, 2023. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines ("AGIL" or "the Group") transported 2.0 million passengers in February 2023; a 19.7% increase when compared to February 2022. AGIL's total capacity deployment increased by 48.3%, to 3.6 billion ASKs from 2.4 billion in the same period of 2022. Total RPKs for the period increased by 42.6% to reach 2.8 billion in February 2023, from 2.0 billion in February 2022.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for February 2023 increased by 60.7% year-on-year. February 2023 RPKs increased by 56.0%, with a 80.2% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for February 2023 increased by 14.2% year-on-year, with a 5.7% increase in RPKs and a Load Factor of 76.1%.

Cargo ATKs in February 2023 increased by 14.6% year-on-year, with a 11.2% RTKs increase as compared to February 2022 and a Load Factor of 63.2%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
