

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED REPORTS FEBRUARY 2025 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – March 14, 2025. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines ("AGIL" or "the Group") transported 2.6 million passengers in February 2025; an 8.1% decrease when compared to February 2024. AGIL's total capacity deployment increased by 12.3%, to 5.2 billion ASKs from 4.6 billion in the same period of 2024. Total RPKs for the period increased by 5.4% to reach 3.8 billion in February 2025, from 3.6 billion in February 2024.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for February 2025 increased by 20.5% year-on-year. February 2025 RPKs increased by 11.6%, with an 73.7% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for February 2025 decreased by 14.9% year-on-year, with a 16.0% decrease in RPKs and a Load Factor of 75.4%.

• Cargo ATKs in February 2025 increased by 2.4% year-on-year, with a 0.9% RTKs decrease as compared to February 2024 and a Load Factor of 60.1%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
