

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

REPORTS APRIL 2025 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – May 15, 2025. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines (“AGIL” or “the Group”) transported 2.8 million passengers in April 2025; an 4.2% decrease when compared to April 2024. AGIL’s total capacity deployment increased by 14.6%, to 5.6 billion ASKs from 4.8 billion in the same period of 2024. Total RPKs for the period increased by 10.6% to reach 4.3 billion in April 2025, from 3.9 billion in April 2024.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for April 2025 increased by 22.1% year-on-year. April 2025 RPKs increased by 17.1%, with a 77.3% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for April 2025 decreased by 12.4% year-on-year, with a 13.7% decrease in RPKs and a Load Factor of 76.4%.

- The passenger operating fleet during April 2025 consisted of 15 Widebody and 134 Narrowbody aircraft. Furthermore, Wamos operating fleet comprised of 14 Widebody aircraft, and the Cargo operating fleet included 7 Freighters in the same period.

Noteworthy Results - Cargo Segment

- Cargo ATKs in April 2025 increased by 13.3% year-on-year, with a 12.4% RTKs increase as compared to April 2024 and a Load Factor of 60.4%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
