Myers; Greenville/Spartanburg; Long Island; Jackson; Midland/Odessa; Panama City Beach; Providence; or West Palm Beach. Seats are limited. Fares may vary by destinations, flight, and day of week and won't be available on some flights that operate during very busy travel times and holiday periods. Fares are available for one-way travel.
