

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED REPORTS MAY 2025 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – June 12, 2025. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines ("AGIL" or "the Group") transported 2.8 million passengers in May 2025; an 6.5% decrease when compared to May 2024. AGIL's total capacity deployment increased by 13.5%, to 5.7 billion ASKs from 5.0 billion in the same period of 2024. Total RPKs for the period increased by 8.2% to reach 4.4 billion in May 2025, from 4.0 billion in May 2024.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for May 2025 increased by 21.5% year-on-year. May 2025 RPKs increased by 13.9%, with a 77.3% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for May 2025 decreased by 15.4% year-on-year, with a 14.4% decrease in RPKs and a Load Factor of 75.3%.

• Cargo ATKs in May 2025 increased by 10.6% year-on-year, with a 11.9% RTKs increase as compared to May 2024 and a Load Factor of 63.6%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
