How young adults read is just as notable. More than eight in ten young adults access Scripture from a mobile device, reflecting a broader shift toward reading the Bible in the ordinary moments of a busy day. The study found that tools like translations and classic commentaries such as Matthew Henry’s now rank among the most-visited resources for this age group, suggesting a growing appetite for deeper understanding and biblical wisdom rather than quick reference alone.
