During operation, the CHP plant will generate 75 kW of electricity and twice that amount of energy in the form of hot water to supplement the facility's heating system.

Power generation by the CHP system will be produced at twice the efficiency of the electric power grid, resulting in proportionally lower carbon emissions and operating costs to the county.
