

TerrAscend Announces Results of Annual General and Special Meeting of Shareholders

Shareholders approve reorganization necessary to list on the Toronto Stock Exchange

TORONTO, June 23, 2023 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- <u>TerrAscend Corp.</u> ("TerrAscend" or the "Company") (CSE: TER) (OTCQX: TRSSF), a leading North American cannabis operator, today announced the results of its annual meeting of shareholders held on June 22, 2023 (the "Meeting"). Common shareholders at the Meeting affirmatively approved the following resolutions:

- the re-appointment of Mr. Craig Collard, Ms. Ira Duarte, Mr. Ed Schutter, Ms. Kara DioGuardi and Mr. Jason Wild as directors of the Company;
- the re-appointment of MNP LLP as the auditor of the Company and the authorization of the Company's board of directors to fix the auditor's remuneration;
- amendments to the Company's stock option plan to conform with the provisions of the TSX Company Manual;
- amendments to the Company's share unit plan to conform with the provisions of the TSX Company Manual; and
- the reorganization necessary to achieve a listing on the Toronto Stock Exchange.

"We are thrilled to have the overwhelming support of our shareholders," commented Jason Wild, Executive Chairman of TerrAscend. "We have a lot to look forward to in the coming weeks as we approach our anticipated listing on the TSX in early July."
