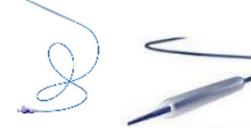

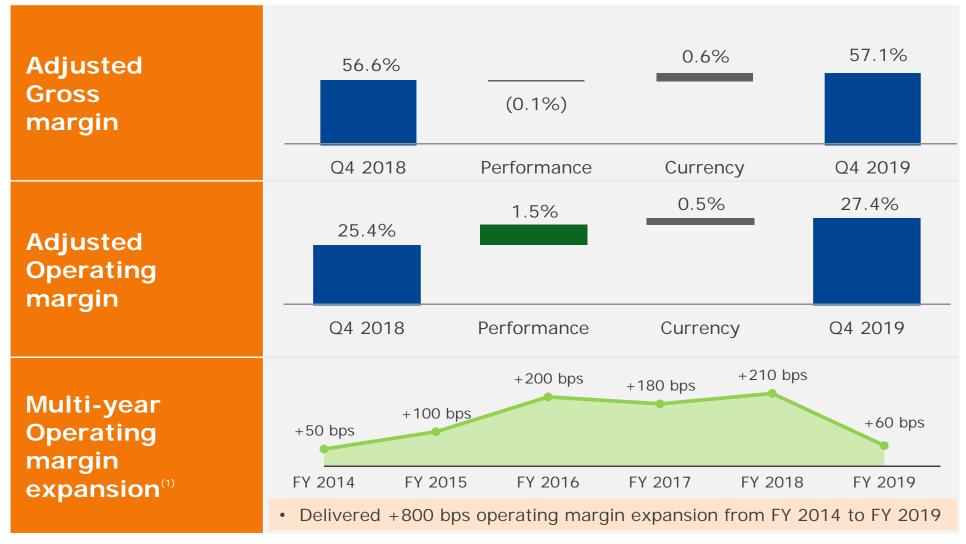

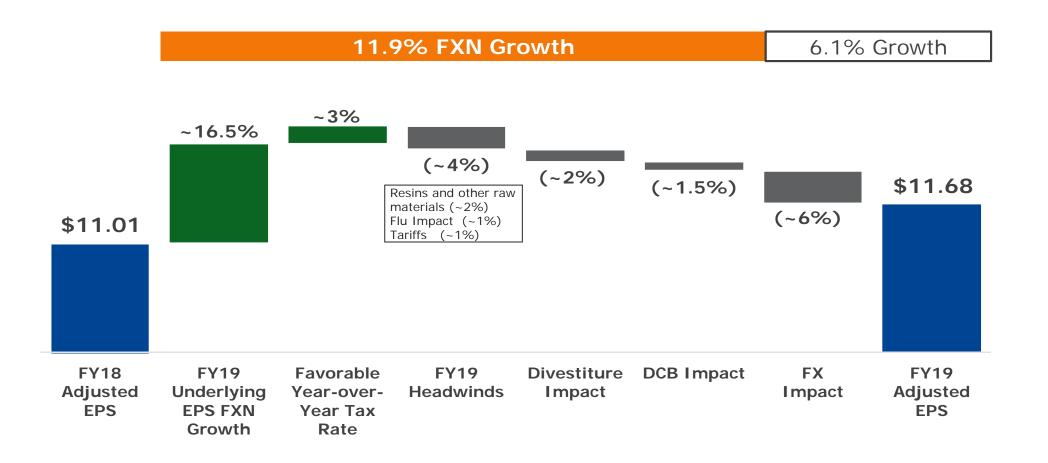
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# Q4 FY 2019 adjusted gross and operating margins

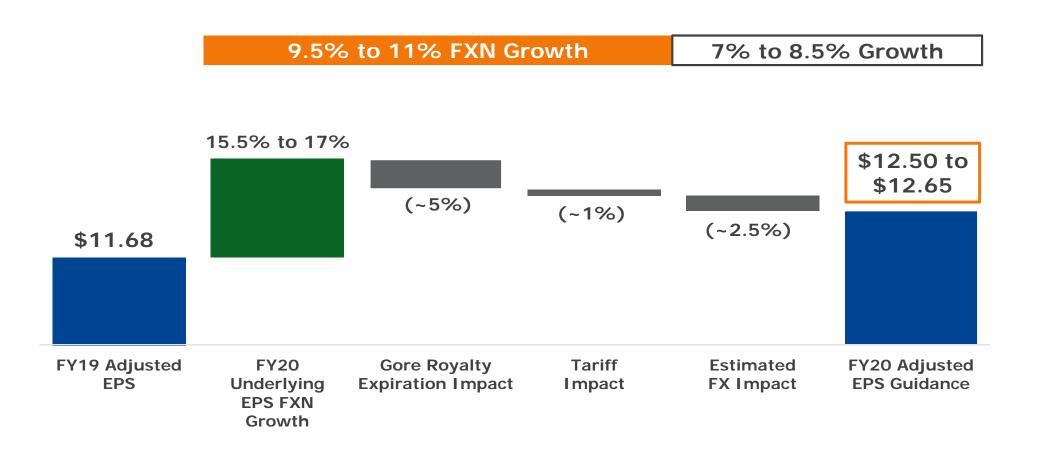

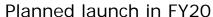

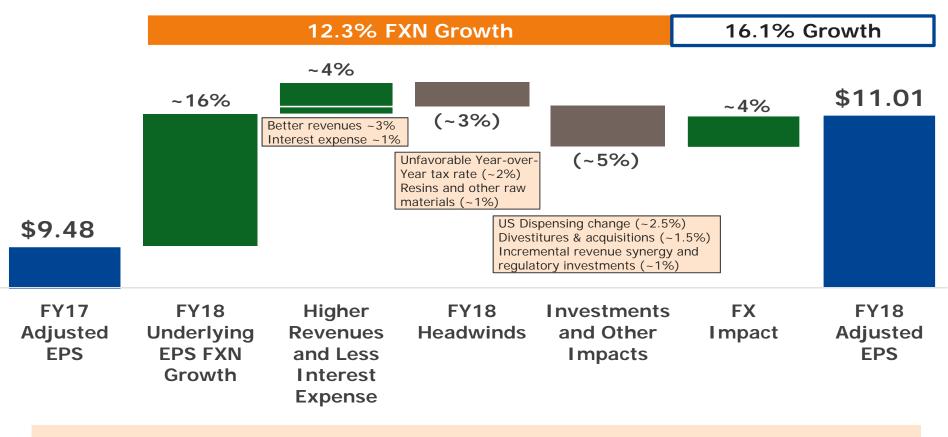
