With a \$1 million restoration -- from an 8k scan of the original 65 mm camera negative -- this was the highest resolution restoration ever completed by the Studio. The restoration was completed in 4k resolution, and the elements were created to preserve the film for the next 100 years. Each set contains more than four hours of extras including a unique, all-new hi-def feature length documentary hosted by son Fraser Heston; a reproduction of Heston's diary during filming; and an exclusive hardbound photo book.
