- C. In March 2023, the Company agreed to enter into voluntary mediation with the landlord of its former facility in East Rutherford, New Jersey. The lease for the facility expired in May 2022. The Company had previously sub-let the facility which expired concurrently with the expiration of the lease. The landlord has refused to return the Company's security deposit in the amount of \$354,550 claiming that the Company owed money to the landlord in amounts exceeding the deposit. The Company has denied the claims of the landlord and is seeking return of the entire security deposit. The Company is holding a security deposit of \$147,853 from the sub-tenant and has not returned the security deposit due to the claims from the landlord. The mediation was non-binding and did not result in a settlement. The Company was served on June 8, 2023, that the landlord commenced an action in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division, Bergen County. The Company has responded with counterclaims. The Company vigorously denies the landlords claims and believes that the Company will prevail in the return of its security deposit.
