Live Nation Entertainment engages with policymakers at all levels to support artists, venues, fans and the broader live music industry.

In 2025, our efforts were largely focused on advocating for artist and fan-friendly reforms that have broad support from many in our industry including: banning speculative tickets, enforcement of anti-bots laws, and giving artists control over how their tickets can be resold. Additionally, we worked on stronger drone safety laws, food & beverage regulations and other reforms that strengthen the safety and security of live events.

We publish an annual report on our corporate political contributions, detailing recipients and amounts given to political candidates.\*

All direct corporate contributions require proper approvals before distribution, and are reviewed annually by our Board's Audit Committee
