

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

REPORTS DECEMBER 2024 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – January 13, 2025. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines (“AGIL” or “the Group”) transported 3.3 million passengers in December 2024; a 2.0% increase when compared to December 2023. AGIL’s total capacity deployment increased by 13.3%, to 6.2 billion ASKs from 5.4 billion in the same period of 2023. Total RPKs for the period increased by 9.7% to reach 5.0 billion in December 2024, from 4.5 billion in December 2023.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for December 2024 increased by 18.5% year-on-year. December 2024 RPKs increased by 14.2%, with an 80.1% Load Factor.
- Domestic ASKs for December 2024 decreased by 6.7% year-on-year, with a 7.6% decrease in RPKs and a Load Factor of 82.1%.

Noteworthy Results - Cargo Segment

- Cargo ATKs in December 2024 increased by 6.1% year-on-year, with a 10.4% RTKs increase as compared to December 2023 and a Load Factor of 64.9%.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
