NETL's Energy Data eXchange (EDX) Development and Operations Team Receives
Prestigious Achievement Award

In March 2021, Maximus acquired Attain Federal which works with NETL as the prime contractor of the Information Technology Support Services (ITSS) contract. The team also supports the NETL team with project and operations management and Geographical Information System (GIS) expertise.
