The propellant used in traditional aerosol cans is liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), comprised of butane and propane, which are common fuels for everything from engines to portable stoves.

"Many traditional aerosol products are toxic, flammable and carbon foot printing. You shouldn't have to open up a window just to clean your bathroom," said Ross Sklar, Chief Executive Officer, Starco Brands. "That's why we created Breathe, which is nontoxic and powered by air, so it's safer for people, pets and the environment."

The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) associates the following health risks with traditional aerosol LPG propellants:

- Difficulty walking or speaking
- Nausea/light-headedness
- Cardiac Arrhythmia (irregular heartbeat)
- Asphyxia (loss of consciousness)

"While developing this product line, we discovered users of household cleaning products were hesitant to use aerosols for fear of exposing themselves to dangerous toxic fumes," said Sklar. "Think of Breathe as the next generation of aerosols, or 'aerosols 2.0' -- third-

party verified performance with zero inhalation risk -- giving consumers the confidence that cleaning with aerosols is now safe and effective."

The EPA's Safer Choice program has certified more than 2,000 products manufactured by more than 500 partner companies. For more than 15 years, products that carry the Safer Choice approval have been evaluated by the EPA to ensure they perform and contain nontoxic ingredients that are safer for human health and the environment.
