

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

REPORTS FEBRUARY 2026 TRAFFIC

Bogota, Colombia – March 18, 2026. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines (“AGIL” or “the Group”) transported 2.9 million passengers in February 2026; a 10.5% increase when compared to February 2025. AGIL’s total capacity deployment increased by 4.0%, to 5.4 billion ASKs from 5.2 billion in the same period of 2025. Total RPKs for the period increased by 14.1% to reach 4.4 billion in February 2026, from 3.8 billion in February 2025. Departures in February 2026 increased by 5.1% to 21.0 thousand from 20.0 thousand in the same period of 2025.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for February 2026 increased by 3.8% year-on-year. February 2026 RPKs increased by 15.3%, with an 81.8% Load Factor. Departures for February 2026 increased by 2.2% year-on-year.
- Domestic ASKs for February 2026 increased by 5.3% year-on-year, with an 8.9% increase in RPKs and a Load Factor of 77.9%. Departures increased by 7.2% year-on-year.

- The passenger operating fleet during February 2026 consisted of 15 Widebody and 136 Narrowbody aircraft. Furthermore, Wamos operating fleet comprised of 13 Widebody aircraft, and the Cargo operating fleet included 9 Freighters in the same period.

Noteworthy Results - Cargo Segment

- Cargo ATKs in February 2026 decreased by 10.2% year-on-year, with an 18.0% RTKs increase as compared to February 2025 and a Load Factor of 64.6%. Departures in February 2026 increased by 28.3% year-on-year.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
