Under Cooper's leadership, the Tacomabased company has made several strategic acquisitions to expand its market presence. TrueBlue was the first publicly-owned company in Washington to receive gold-standard accreditation from the CEO Roundtable on Cancer for programs to reduce cancer risk and provide access to cancer care.
