






Business Continues to be Highly Diversified Across Lines of Business, Geography and Industry

Diversified Mix of Revenue & Earnings (\$M)











Quarterly New Business* - YoY Growth (Excluding RPO)







Quarterly New Business* - YoY Growth By Line of Business (Excluding RPO)












