The XP3.2 Quest Pro's rugged design makes it the ideal choice for active users in all environments - on the ski hill, at a construction site, on an oil rig or climbing a rock face. The Sonim XP3.2 Quest Pro:

- -- features a shockproof Gorilla Glass Lens for scratch and smash
 resistance;
- -- includes top-line lithium ion batteries capable of providing 1500 hours of standby time and up to 18 hours of talk time;
- -- has a customized keypad and widely-spaced keys that are tested to 850,000 pushes (users can make calls without removing their gloves);
- -- is Push-to-talk capable, whereby it can be used in the same way as a Private Mobile Radio handset for one-to-one or one-to-many communications over the cellular network.

The XP3.2 Quest Pro goes beyond the military-level MIL-810G certification for resistance to humidity, salt, shock and heat. It is equipped with a 2MP camera with built-in flash, assisted GPS, a flashlight, an FM radio, a 2GB memory slot, enhanced Java applications such as Trimble Outdoors, amAze GPS navigation, SonimMail and the ability to support a number of other enterprise-ready applications, an Opera Mini browser and Bluetooth.
