The 1,837-square-foot, three-bedroom, two-bathroom ranch home will include a two-car garage, private study/flex room, a covered outdoor living area and the M.Connected Home[™] Automation Suite. It will also include an array of money-saving features, such as ENERGY STAR® appliances, spray-foam insulation, and energy-efficient windows, that cut heating and cooling costs by as much as 50 percent.

Last year, a home was donated in a Meritage community in Northlake, Texas. Army Specialist William Robbin, his wife Nikki, and their three children received that home.
