This addition increases Microchip's reach to the broad global base that Avnet Electronics Marketing in Asia, Avnet Memec in the Americas and Avnet Silica in Europe currently support. Avnet Memec's focused and select line card of semiconductor suppliers, concentration on demand creation and dedicated field application engineers fit very well in Microchip's worldwide technical customer support model.

Avnet is pleased to expand our relationship with Microchip worldwide, and we look forward to better serving our joint customers by driving accelerated success through Avnet's global design chain and supply chain services." Vallee further stated, "Avnet's global footprint comprised of regionally specialized businesses is ideally suited for meeting the dynamic needs of Microchip and our customers."

Robert Miller, President and CEO of Future Electronics, commented, "Microchip and Future have enjoyed a close working relationship since the early 1990s. We were the first distributor to sell their products to a global customer base. We are excited about Microchip's new global distribution program and the opportunities that it presents to Future Electronics."

In addition, Microchip also announced that it has terminated its relationship with Arrow Electronics, effective immediately. The relationship with Arrow was limited to Europe and the Americas, and represented approximately 7% of Microchip's sales.

Microchip is working with all of its channel partners to ensure that its customers have continuity of supply and support through this transition phase. Delivery times for most Microchip products remain at less than three weeks, providing quick, ample supply when required by customers.

Mr. Sanghi concluded, "We believe that today's changes will have substantial long-term benefits to serving the technical and commercial support needs of our customers. This change adds Avnet Memec to our large network of regional distributors that create demand for our products around the world. Additionally this change enhances the strong relationship that we have enjoyed with Future Electronics for the last 17 years. From the corporate revenue perspective, the positioning of our proprietary products will allow a seamless transfer of customers to the new distributor network in Americas and Europe."
