- -- cash rewards of up to \$300 for points earned by completing wellness activities such as fun runs, bicycling to work, yoga and other exercise classes, sports programs, and being up-to-date with preventive health

-- annual company participation in events such as the JPMorgan Chase Corporate Challenge, where 205 Rochester employees this year were treated to free Paychex-themed, moisture-wicking race shirts and post-race hospitality
