15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ A portion of each distribution made by Chimera Investment Corporation in 2013 and 2014 attributable to the 2013 tax year is not taxable as a dividend under Section 301(c)(1), but is applied against basis under Section 301(c)(2). The return of capital on a per share basis is listed in the table above.

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ Chimera Investment Corporation calculated Earnings and Profits in accordance with IRC Section 312, as modified by IRC Section 857(d) for a Real Estate Investment Trust and the regulations thereunder. The amount of distributions in excess of Earnings and Profits reduces shareholders' basis in its shares of stock to the extent of basis.
