Founded in 1987, GRACE offers emergency-assistance programs, medical services, transitional-housing placements, food, clothing and other vital services to more than 4,500 individuals and families annually.

"This gift is a huge blessing to GRACE and the community we serve," said Shonda Schaefer, executive director of GRACE. "Thanks to the generosity of ExxonMobil we will be able to create opportunity and hope for 500 additional families."

Tillerson established the holiday gift in 2006 to provide support to North Texas nonprofit agencies during the holiday season.
