

## SUMMARY OF 2017 PROXY VOTING RESULTS

ExxonMobil thanks the many shareholders who returned their proxies. More than 3.6 billion, or over 85 percent, of the outstanding shares were represented at this year's meeting.

On average, about 93 percent of the votes were cast for the 11 persons nominated by the Board to serve as directors: Susan K. Avery, Michael J. Boskin, Angela F. Braly, Ursula M. Burns, Henrietta H. Fore, Kenneth C. Frazier, Douglas R. Oberhelman, Samuel J. Palmisano, Steven S Reinemund, William C. Weldon, and Darren W. Woods.

The Ratification of Independent Auditors, Advisory Vote to Approve Executive Compensation, Frequency of Advisory Vote on Executive Compensation, and the nine shareholder proposals received votes as detailed in the table below.
