ShotSpotter Announces Public Offering of Common Stock

NEWARK, Calif., March 05, 2019 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- ShotSpotter, Inc.

(NASDAQ:SSTI) today announced the sale of an aggregate of 385,539 shares of its common stock, which includes 135,539 shares that certain selling stockholders have agreed to sell and 250,000 shares that the Company has agreed to sell, in an underwritten public offering. The Company also has granted the underwriter a 30-day option to purchase up to an additional 57,830 shares.

The Company expects to use the net proceeds from the offering for working capital and general corporate purposes. The Company will not receive any proceeds from the sale of the shares by the selling stockholders.

JMP Securities is acting as the sole underwriter for the offering.

This offering is being conducted pursuant to the Company's currently effective shelf registration statement, which was previously filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission.
