- **Protecting the Environment:** By concentrating environmental sustainability efforts on reducing the impact of its operations and products, by the end of fiscal 2013, BD had reached 80 percent of its 2015 sustainability targets. Key initiatives such as its wind energy project in Nebraska have contributed to this early success.
- Making BD an Even Better Place to Work: In 2013 we created a new Leadership Standard and programs to develop skills and identify talent at BD. The Company also established the Women's Initiative Network (WIN) with the goal of creating a best-in-class work environment that leverages gender diversity at all levels of the Company.
