Conshohocken is a plate-finishing facility located on the Schuylkill River, adjacent to Philadelphia. The area is surrounded by highway and railroad systems that allow for excellent shipping access. Coatesville supplies steel plate to the Conshohocken plant, which operates heat treat, finishing and inspection facilities for steel plate finishing.
