- Results of a survey about the state of the RPA developer community. The survey report will detail how RPA developers view their roles, the tools they're using to upskill and certifications they have, the projects they work on most often and enjoy, whether they think it's a valuable career path, and advice they have for others exploring the field. Initial survey results show that 91% of RPA developers think the RPA industry has a high potential for growth over the next five years and 83% think their job as an RPA developer will have a positive impact on their next career move.
