The COMPASS Patient Assistance Program

Many insurance plans cover Interpace Diagnostics test panels when a physician determines they are medically necessary and appropriate. If a health plan does not cover these tests and financial assistance is needed to offset the cost, Interpace may be able to help through the COMPASS patient assistance program.*

How Does it Work?

- 1 On your behalf, Interpace Diagnostics will handle the claim submission for your test with your insurance carrier.
- You may receive an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from your insurance carrier. This EOB is not a bill.
- 3 If there is a balance due after insurance or if you are a self-pay patient, you will receive a statement from Interpace Diagnostics. If you need financial assistance, our COMPASS program may be able to help.

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All tests provided by Interpace Diagnostics are covered by the COMPASS program, which can minimize or eliminate out-of-pocket costs for all eligible uninsured and commercially insured patients.*

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
