



Garden

- Millennials have become homeowners in large numbers, representing 29% of all gardeners.
- Rural revitalization is a tailwind for the garden industry as a large portion of the population now live either full-time or part-time outside of cities and in more suburban or rural areas thus providing more space for larger lawns.
- 75% of gardeners believe they have a personal responsibility to be environmentally friendly.

Pet

- 95% of U.S. pet owners view pets as family, and humanization is a significant tailwind for the pet industry.
- Online shopping in Pet has continued to grow much faster than brick and mortar retail. In fact, 80% of the U.S. population shops online and more than half of U.S. consumers prefer it over in-person.
- Almost 90% of pet owners agree that they look for products to improve their pet's health and well-being.
