2000: Third MDI plant and nitrobenzene and aniline plants added in major expansion

2009: Maleic anhydride plant added

2013: MDI capacity expanded using improved process technology developed by Huntsman

2017: JEFFOL® specialty polyether polyols capacity expansion

2019: Construction of new MDI splitter began
