

AVIANCA GROUP INTERNATIONAL LIMITED

REPORTS MAY 2026 TRAFFIC

Bogotá, Colombia – June 18, 2026. Traffic Report. Avianca Group International Limited affiliated passenger airlines (“AGIL” or “the Group”) transported 3.0 million passengers in May 2026; a 7.4% increase when compared to May 2025. AGIL’s total capacity deployment increased by 7.4%, to 6.1 billion ASKs from 5.7 billion in the same period of 2025. Total RPKs for the period increased by 10.2% to reach 4.8 billion in May 2026, from 4.4 billion in May 2025. Departures in May 2026 increased by 6.5% to 22.8 thousand from 21.4 thousand in the same period of 2025.

Noteworthy Results - Passenger Segment

- International operation ASKs for May 2026 increased by 7.9% year-on-year. May 2026 RPKs increased by 10.8%, with a 79.4% Load Factor. Departures for May 2026 increased by 3.7% year-on-year.
- Domestic ASKs for May 2026 increased by 4.9% year-on-year, with a 6.9% increase in RPKs and a Load Factor of 76.7%. Departures increased by 8.8% year-on-year.

Noteworthy Results - Cargo Segment

- Cargo ATKs in May 2026 increased by 7.1% year-on-year, with a 9.2% RTKs increase as compared to May 2025 and a Load Factor of 65.5%. Departures in May 2026 increased by 21.9% year-on-year.

Glossary

Available Seats Kilometer (ASK).

Available seat kilometers represent aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

Revenue Passenger Kilometer (RPK).

Revenue passenger kilometers represent the number of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

Available Ton Kilometer (ATK).

One Tons carried one kilometer (whether occupied or not).

Revenue Ton Kilometer (RTK).

Revenue ton kilometers represents the total cargo tonnage transported multiplied by the number of kilometers the cargo is flown.

Percentage Point (PP).

The difference between two percentages is termed as percentage point. Percentage point is used to show the changes in an indicator with respect to its previous standings. One percentage point is also equal to 100 basis points.
