The Cleveland facility is supplied with coke from our cokemaking operations in Warren, Ohio and Monessen, PA. Cleveland's major production facilities include two blast furnaces, two steel producing facilities, an 84-inch hot strip mill, a pickling line, a five-stand tandem mill, and a hot dip coating line.
