

To the 2 issuers who successfully cross-listed from a foreign exchange to the Nasdaq and NYSE this month.





UPLISTING SUMMARY

The uplisting and the cross-listing market continued its slow start of the year, with 2 issuers cross-listing from foreign exchanges to senior U.S. exchanges in February, raising a total of \$252 million.

Neither of the two cross-listing issuers is from the Micro-Cap space (issuers with \$300 million market cap). Both the cross-listing issuers operate in the energy sector.

One of the newly exchange traded companies cross-listed from the Toronto Stock Exchange, listing on NYSE American organically (without consummating an underwritten public offering).

The other issuer cross-listed from the Tel Aviv Stock Exchange, partnering with JP Morgan Securities and BofA Securities to complete a \$252,000,000 simultaneous underwritten public offering in the process. No warrants were included in the offering.

Overall, the uplisting and cross-listing market continued to be slow in February, with no Micro-Cap issuers uplisting or crosslisting to senior U.S. exchanges.

CROSS-LIST ASSISTED BY INVESTMENT BANKERS








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The two issuers cross-listing in February are from the small-cap space
