#### Segment Realignment

The company realigned its reportable segments during the first quarter of 2024 to correspond with changes in its business designed to further enhance operational performance in the delivery of its integrated portfolio of products and solutions to its financial institution clients (the "Segment Realignment"). The company's new reportable segments are Merchant Solutions and Financial Solutions. Segment results for 2023 have been recast to reflect the Segment Realignment. Additional information regarding the Segment Realignment is available in the Current Report on Form 8-K filed by the company on March 26, 2024.

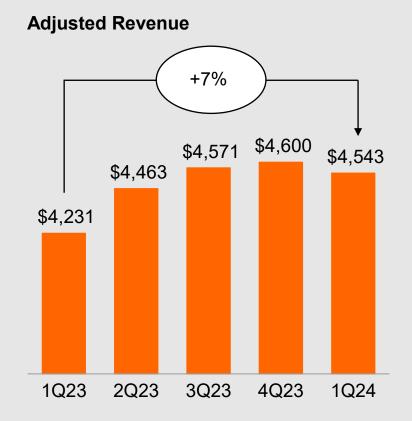

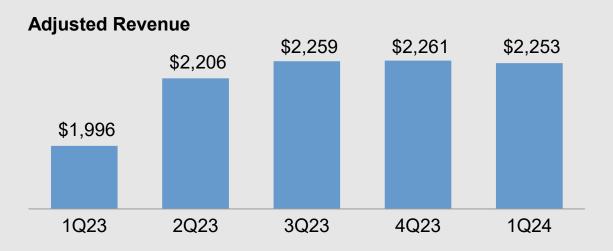

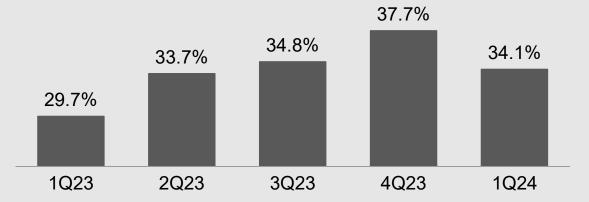

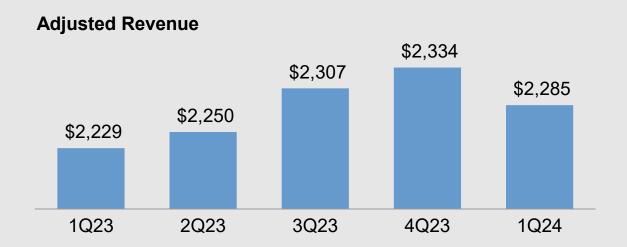

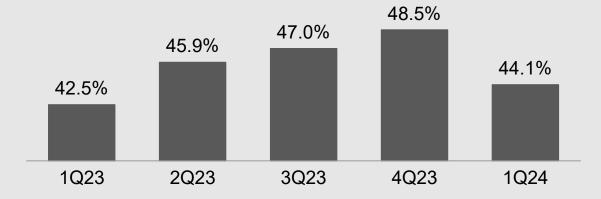

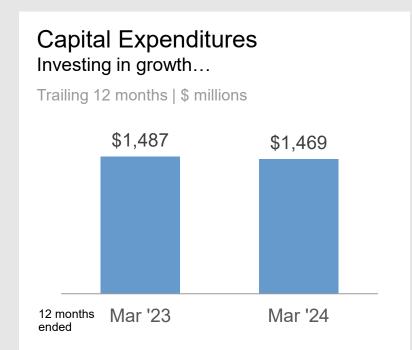

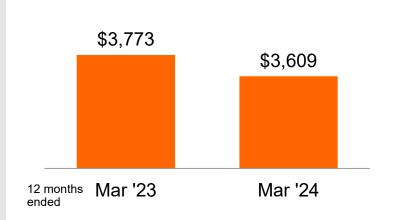

The company's forward-looking non-GAAP financial measures for 2024, including organic revenue growth, adjusted earnings per share, adjusted earnings per share growth, adjusted operating margin expansion, and free cash flow, are designed to enhance shareholders' ability to evaluate the company's performance by excluding certain items to focus on factors and trends affecting its business. The company's organic revenue growth outlook excludes the impact of foreign currency fluctuations, acquisitions, dispositions and the company's postage reimbursements. Estimates of these impacts and adjustments on a forward-looking basis are presented on the slide titled "2024 Performance Outlook - Organic Revenue Growth" and are subject to variability. The company's adjusted earnings per share and adjusted operating margin outlooks exclude certain non-cash or other items such as non-cash intangible asset amortization expense associated with acquisitions; non-cash impairment charges; non-cash pension plan termination charges; merger and integration costs; severance costs; gains or losses from the sale of businesses, certain assets and investments; and certain discrete tax benefits and expenses. The company's adjusted operating margin outlook also excludes the impact of the company's postage reimbursements. The company's free cash flow outlook includes, but is not limited to, capital expenditures, distributions paid to noncontrolling interests, and distributions from unconsolidated affiliates and excludes severance, merger and integration payments. The company estimates that amortization expense in 2024 with respect to acquired intangible assets will decrease approximately 10% compared to the amount incurred in 2023. Other adjustments to the company's financial measures that were incurred in 2023 and for the three months ended March 31, 2024 are presented on the subsequent pages of this presentation; however, they are not necessarily indicative of adjustments that may be incurred throughout the remainder of 2024 or beyond. Estimates of these impacts and adjustments on a forward-looking basis are not available due to the variability, complexity and limited visibility of these items.

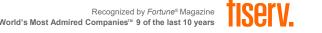

# Adjusted Net Income and Adjusted EPS (cont.)

The company adjusts its non-GAAP results to exclude amortization of acquisition-related intangible assets as such amounts are inconsistent in amount and frequency and are significantly impacted by the timing and/or size of acquisitions. Management believes that the adjustment of acquisition-related intangible asset amortization supplements the GAAP information with a measure that can be used to assess the comparability of operating performance. Although the company excludes amortization from acquisition-related intangible assets from its non-GAAP expenses, management believes that it is important for investors to understand that such intangible assets were recorded as part of purchase accounting and contribute to revenue generation. Amortization of intangible assets that relate to past acquisitions will recur in future periods until such intangible assets have been fully amortized. Any future acquisitions may result in the amortization of additional intangible assets.
