Dr. John MacArthur is president and featured teacher of Grace to You, the nonprofit organization responsible for developing, producing, and distributing John's books, audiocassettes, and the "Grace to You" radio program. "Grace to You" airs more than 800 times daily, reaching all major population centers in the United States, as well as Australia, Canada, Europe, India, New Zealand, and South Africa. Dr. MacArthur came to pastor Grace Community Church in 1969, after graduating with honors from Talbot Theological Seminary. The emphasis of his pulpit ministry is the careful study and verse-by-verse

exposition of the Bible, with special attention devoted to the historical and grammatical background behind each passage. In 1985, he was named president of The Master's College (formerly Los Angeles Baptist College), an accredited, four-year, liberal arts Christian college in Santa Clarita, California. Dr. MacArthur founded The Master's Seminary, a graduate school dedicated to training men for full-time pastoral roles and missionary work.
