Main Street and its co-investor partnered with Riverlake Partners, LLC, a private equity firm based in Portland, Oregon, and Guerdon's founder to facilitate the transaction.

Guerdon's portfolio consists of large apartment, condominium, hotel, office, and workforce housing buildings in varying geographies, climates and working conditions.
