

The 2013 Masters to Air Live on SiriusXM

During Masters week, SiriusXM listeners will get extensive coverage of the first major tournament of the season with live play-by-play from storied Augusta National Golf Club in Georgia, plus expert analysis leading up to and throughout the event.

Live hole-by-hole coverage of Tournament play will begin at 2:00 pm ET Thursday through Sunday and cover each day's on-course action with live reports from around Augusta National and updates on golfers moving up and down the leader board. Immediately after the conclusion of each day's play, Adams will host*Masters Review*, giving listeners a full recap of the day's action.
