Hawaii, Here We Come! Southwest Airlines Service For The Hawaiian Islands Now On Sale

- Flights between both Oakland and San Jose, Calif., and the Islands, now available for purchase through March 5 for as low as \$49 one-way.
- Interisland service to begin April 28 between Honolulu and Kahului (Maui), and May 12 between Honolulu and Kona, now available for purchase through March 5 for as low as \$29 one-way.

DALLAS, March 4, 2019 /PRNewswire/ -- [Southwest Airlines Co.](https://www.southwest.com) (NYSE: LUV) today announced the carrier will begin service to Hawaii on March 17, 2019, with an inaugural flight from **Oakland International Airport (OAK)** to **Daniel K. Inouye International Airport (HNL)** in Honolulu, Oahu, followed by an inaugural flight from Oakland to **Kahului Airport (OGG)**, Maui on April 7.

In subsequent weeks, the carrier will inaugurate additional service from **Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport (SJC)** to Honolulu on May 5 and to Kahului on May 26.

Southwest will operate its first interisland service within Hawaii between Honolulu and Kahului, four times daily in each direction, beginning April 28, followed by service between Honolulu and **Ellison Onizuka International Airport at Keahole (KOA)** on Hawaii Island, four times daily in each direction, beginning May 12. The additional interisland service will make possible connecting service between Kona and both Oakland and San Jose.

Additional service details, including plans for previously announced gateways of San Diego and Sacramento, and for Lihue, on Kauai, will be announced in the coming weeks.

"As we answer the call for Southwest in Hawaii with an initial schedule of service that speaks to a long-held hope of our Customers, I applaud and congratulate our People for their steady and impressive work to bring our world-famous Hospitality and game-changing value to the Islands," said [Gary Kelly](#), Southwest Airlines' Chairman & Chief Executive Officer.

With an industry-leading 32-inch seat pitch on Hawaii flights and Islands-inspired drinks and snacks, Southwest proudly will provide world-class service for Hawaii flights, including the carrier's gate-to-gate connectivity on WiFi-enabled aircraft, offering 100 percent free inflight entertainment with free inflight movies^{1^}, free Live TV² and free messaging^{3^}.

"As our first flights go on sale, I want to recognize and thank our People who successfully obtained FAA authorization to operate this service across the Pacific between the mainland and the Hawaiian Islands," said [Mike Van de Ven](#), Southwest Airlines' Chief Operating Officer. "From our work with airports under the direction of the State of Hawaii, to our California airports, and to all business partners who collaborated with us to safely prepare our operation, we gratefully share our thanks."

[In October 2017, Southwest shared an intention to begin the technical work to bring capabilities for Hawaii service.](#) The carrier filed application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in January 2018 and [publicly announced in spring 2018 the carrier's initial mainland gateways and Island airports.](#) The announcements punctuated a multi-year effort by Southwest across the Islands to map cultural and community landscapes with a focus on learning how the Company could best serve the different communities of the Islands of Hawaii with relevant service.

"Hawaii, we're in this for good," said Kelly. "*Mahalo* from all 60,000 of us at Southwest for the warm *aloha* you've shared ahead of our arrival and please know how excited we are to share our Southwest Hospitality with you."

RECAP | SOUTHWEST AIRLINES INITIAL PHASE OF SERVICE FOR HAWAII (chronologically):

- **Oakland to Honolulu** begins once daily on March 17, 2019; **Honolulu to Oakland** begins once daily on March 18; the route will be flown twice daily in each direction as of March 24.
- **Oakland to Kahului** begins once daily on April 7, 2019; **Kahului to Oakland** begins once daily on April 8; the route will be flown twice daily in each direction as of April 10.
- Interisland service four times daily in each direction between **Honolulu and Kahului** begins April 28.
- **San Jose to Honolulu** service begins May 5, once daily in each direction.
- Interisland service four times daily in each direction between **Honolulu and Kona** begins May 12.
- **San Jose to Kahului** service begins May 26, once daily in each direction.

Honolulu travel to/from Kona is valid May 14 through June 19, 2019. Travel is valid on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, & Saturdays. Fares are valid only on nonstop service.

\$49 & \$79 fares between California and Hawaii: Purchase from March 4 through March 5, 2019, 11:59 p.m. Pacific Standard Time. Continental U.S. to Hawaii travel valid March 19 through June 19, 2019. Oakland to/from Honolulu is valid beginning March 19. Oakland to/from Maui is valid beginning April 9. San Jose, CA to/from Honolulu is valid beginning May 7. Oakland and San Jose, CA to/from Kona valid beginning May 14. San Jose, CA to/from Maui is valid beginning May 28. Continental U.S. to Hawaii travel is valid Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Fares valid only on nonstop service. Oakland and San Jose, CA to/from Kona valid on single, connecting service.
