- Equinix was named Data Center Service Provider of the Year based on four key criteria: revenues and revenue growth, regional presence, initiatives and achievements, regional and global footprint, and commitment to innovation, specifically around green technology. The award also recognizes Equinix for its exemplary performance in the region in the past year.
- With growing demand for an Interconnection Oriented Architecture (IOA™), data center facilities and managed services from the enterprise, financial services, network operators, cloud and IT sectors, Asia-Pacific is a key region for Equinix and a desired location for cloud service providers and major multinational organizations.
- With 28 data centers strategically sited throughout Asia-Pacific - including Australia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan and Singapore - Equinix's International Business Exchange™ (IBX®) data centers offer access to Asia's thriving banking, commerce, manufacturing and telecommunications marketplaces.
- Equinix has a total of over 108,000 square meters (1,160,000+ square feet) of colocation space in the region, serving more than 1,450 customers, 350 networks, and 540 cloud and IT service providers.
- In March of this year, Equinix announced the opening of its latest IBX data center in the Japanese capital, Tokyo, known as TY5. The new \$43 million facility supports strong demand from local and global enterprises, including financial services firms, cloud and content providers, that are increasingly relying on data center colocation and interconnection services in Tokyo. This comes as part of a global plan to open four new IBX data centers this year in Dallas, São Paulo, Sydney and Tokyo, to create more capacity for global companies to connect to their partners, customers and employees.
- Equinix is committed to maximum energy efficiency and sustainability in Asia-Pacific, including the use of indirect evaporative coolers at the ME1 facility in Melbourne and a solar energy system that powers non-essential operations at SG3 in Singapore. It was awarded Frost & Sullivan's 2014 and 2015 Asia Pacific Data Center Green Innovation Leadership Award in recognition of this work.
