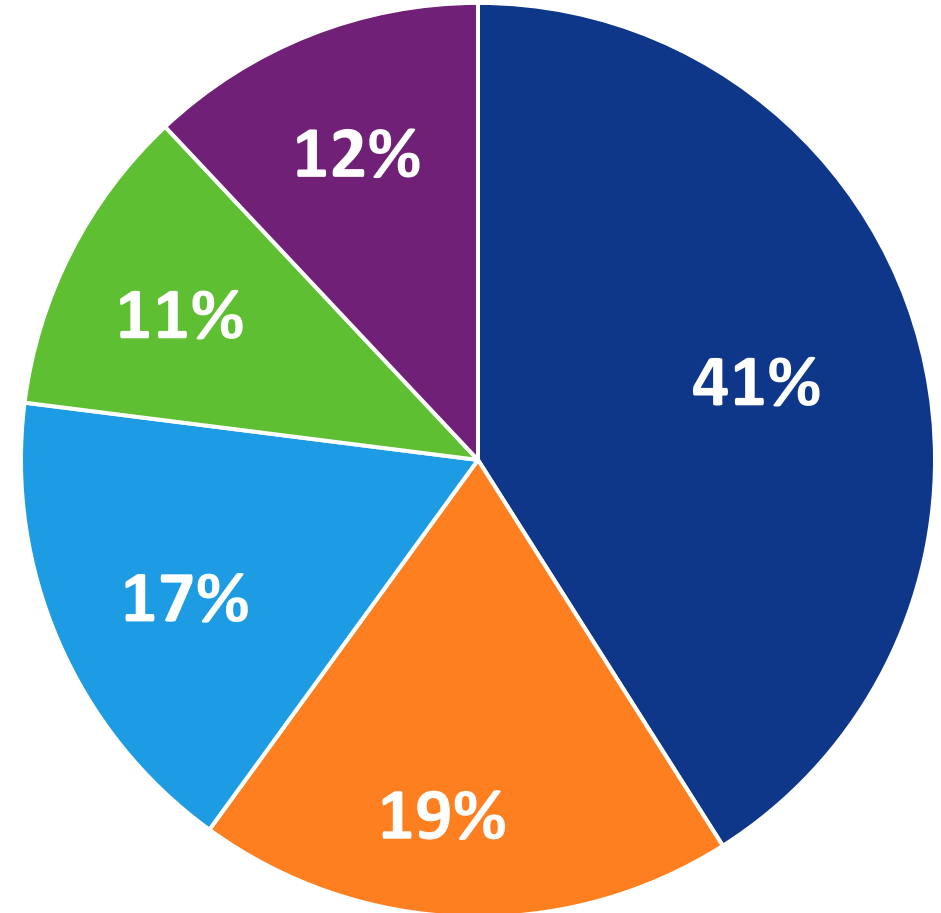
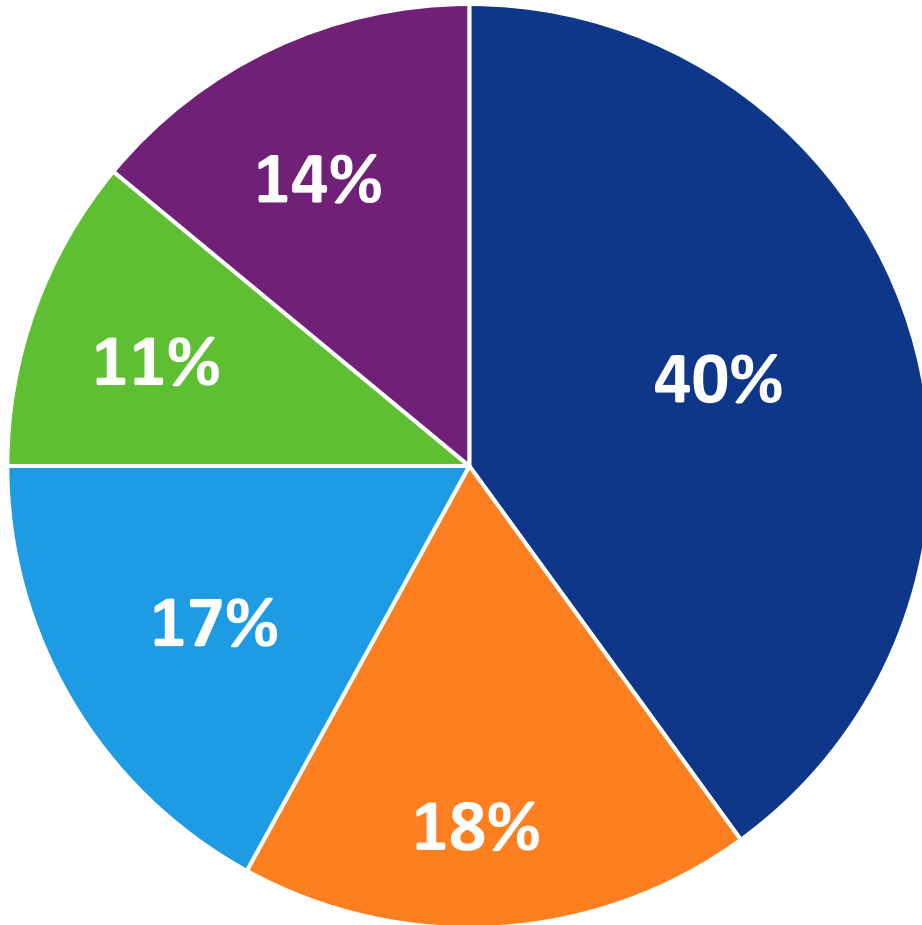

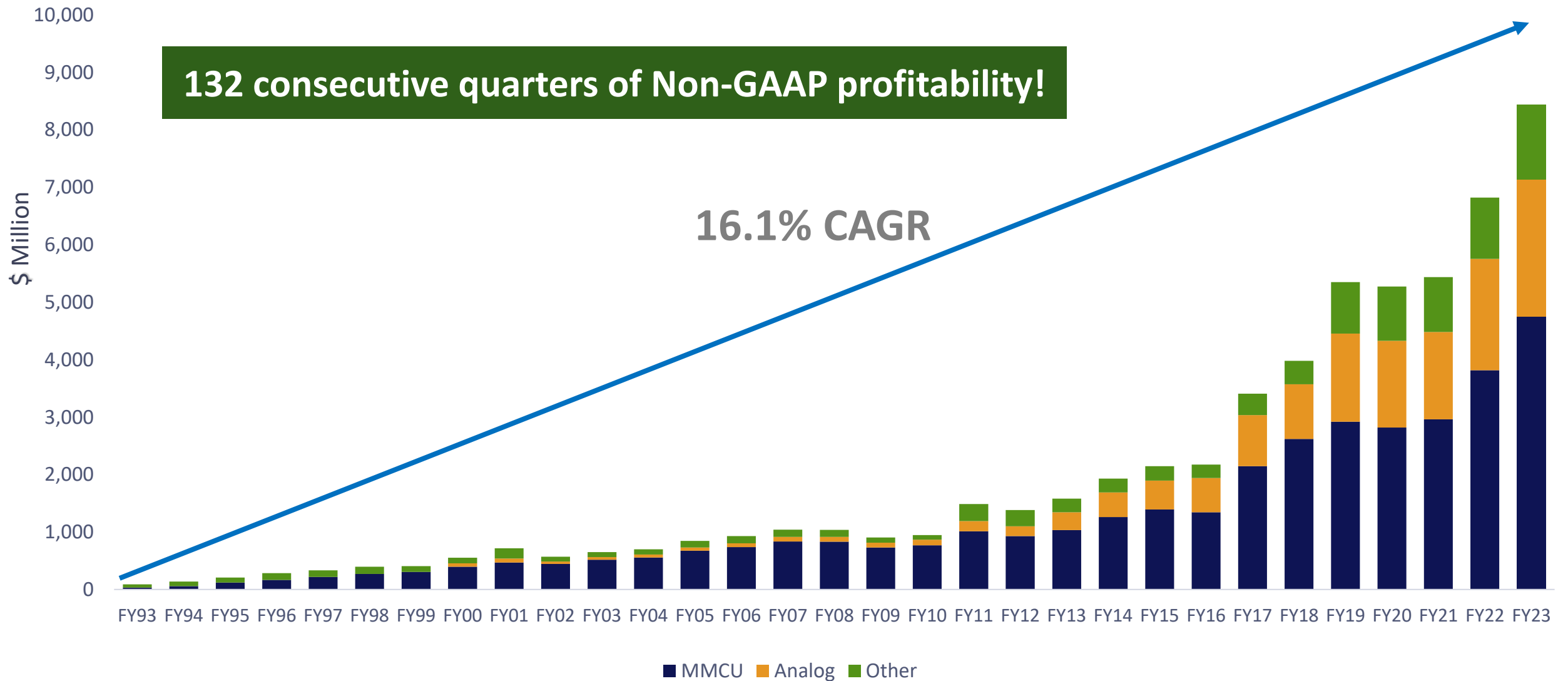

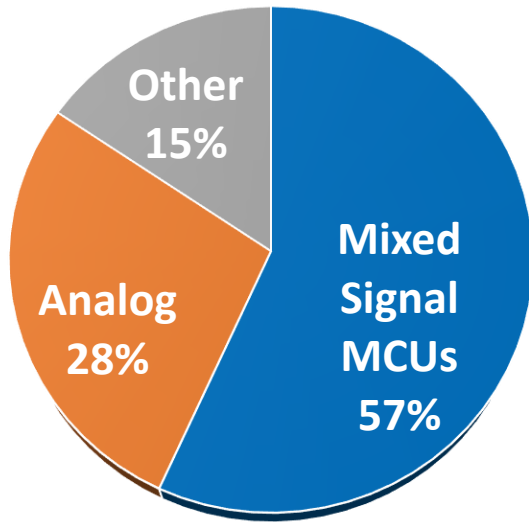

Net Sales Growth

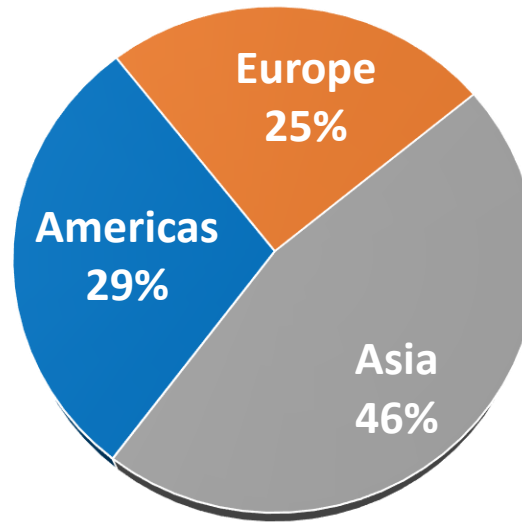


Second Quarter FY2024 Revenue Mix

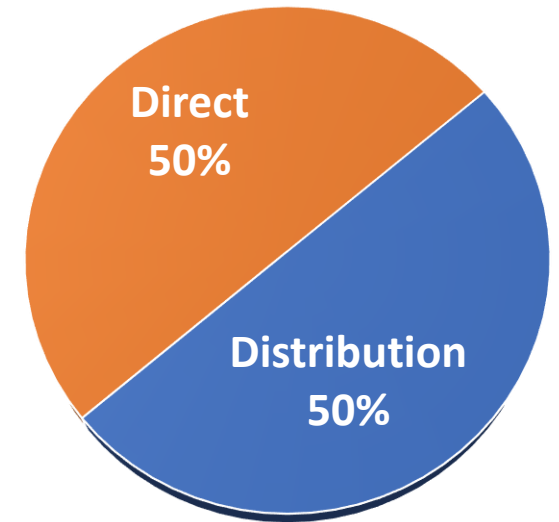
Net Sales by Product Line

Fiscal 2nd Quarter 2024 Results (non-GAAP)

- Revenue of \$2.25 billion; declined 1.5% QoQ and increased 8.7% YoY
- Gross margin of 68.1%; increased 40 basis points YoY
- Operating margin of 48.1%; increased 120 basis points YoY
- Earnings per share of \$1.62; increased 11% YoY
- Restructured Debt with near-term maturities
 - Used new \$750 Term Loan A and credit line to retire \$1 billion Sept. 2023 bonds
 - Issued \$1 billion in commercial paper
- Record adj. TTM EBITDA of \$4.57 billion representing 51.1% of TTM revenue
- Achieved net debt to adj. EBITDA ratio of 1.28x
- Total cash return of \$562.5 million
 - Share repurchases of \$339.8 million and Dividends of \$222.7 million
- Announced record dividend of 43.9 cents per share for Q3FY24 and planned share repurchases of \$114.6 million

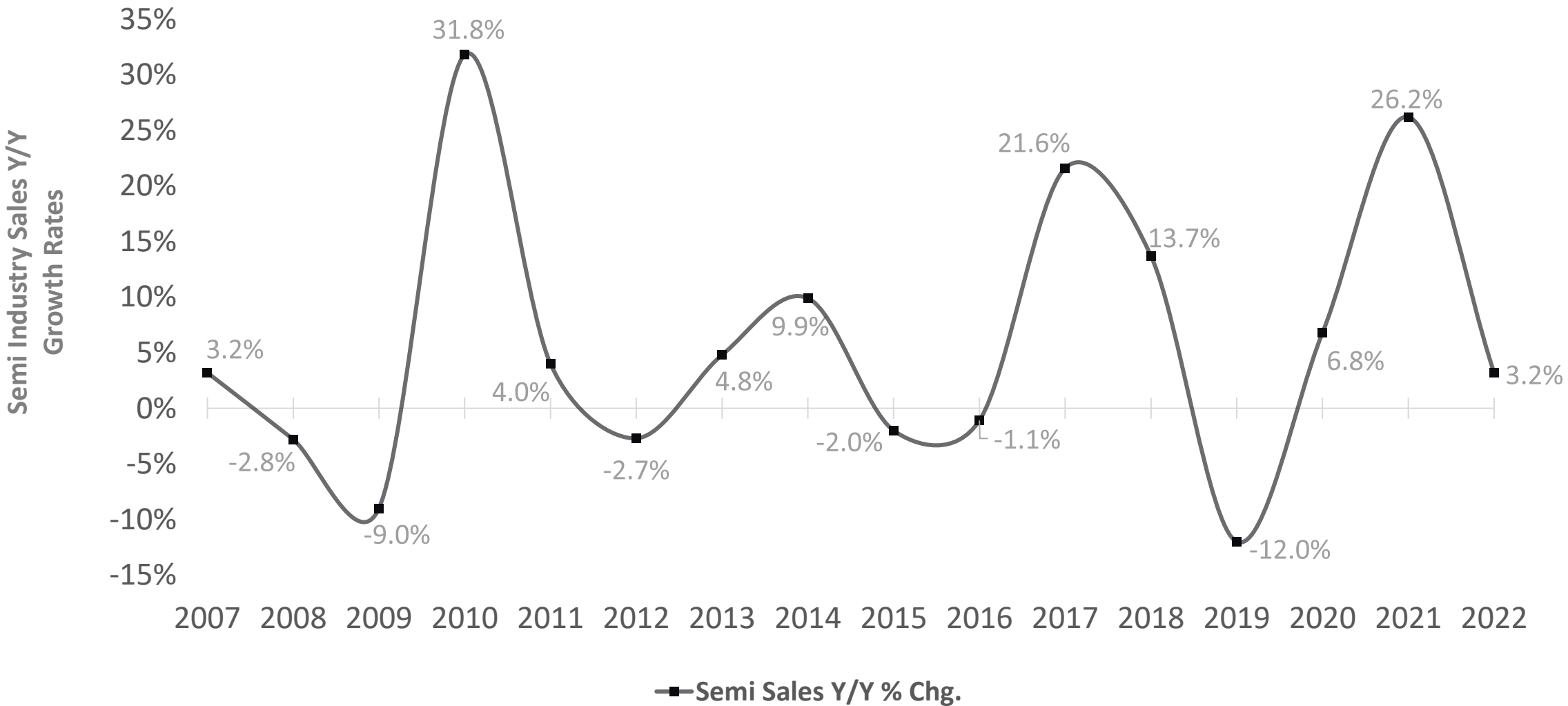

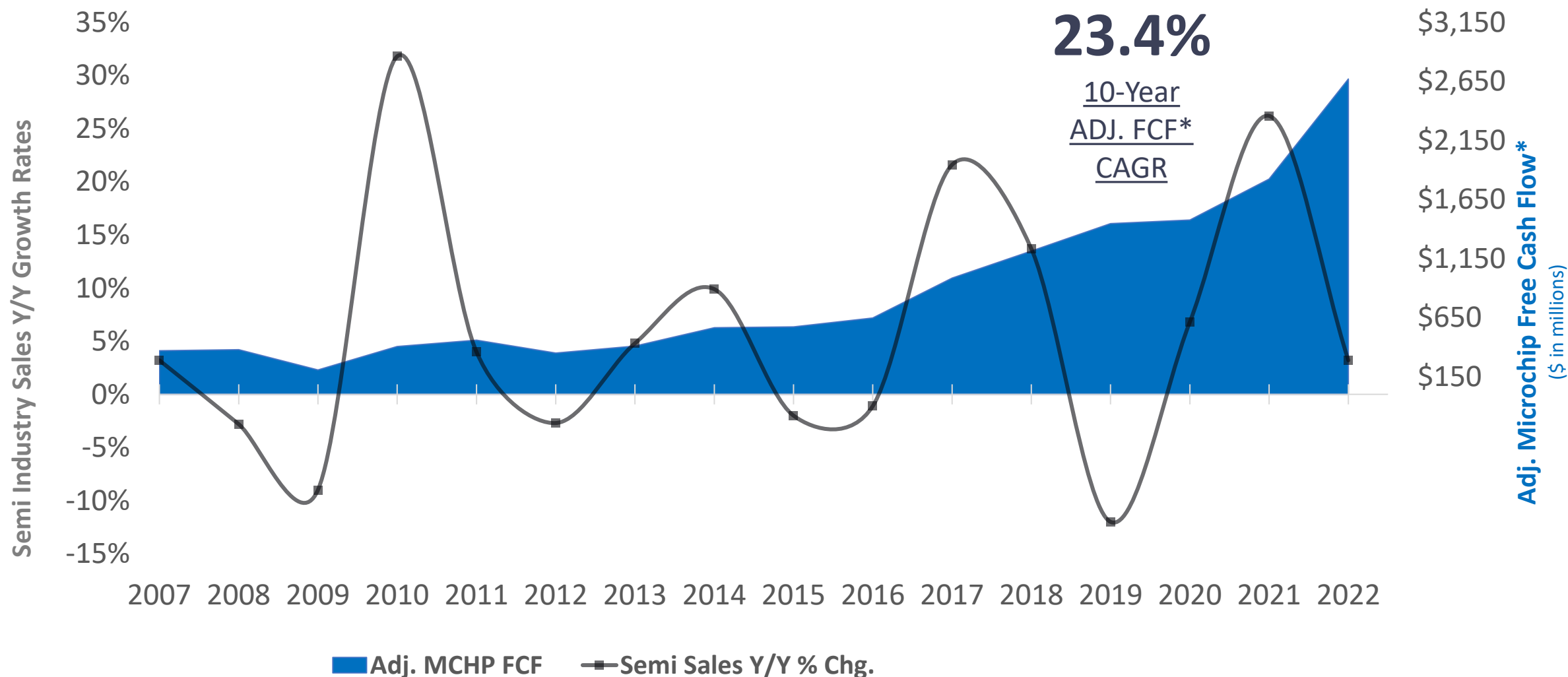

CY2022 est. annual global sales is based on World Semiconductor Trade Statistics Organization (WSTS) industry forecast

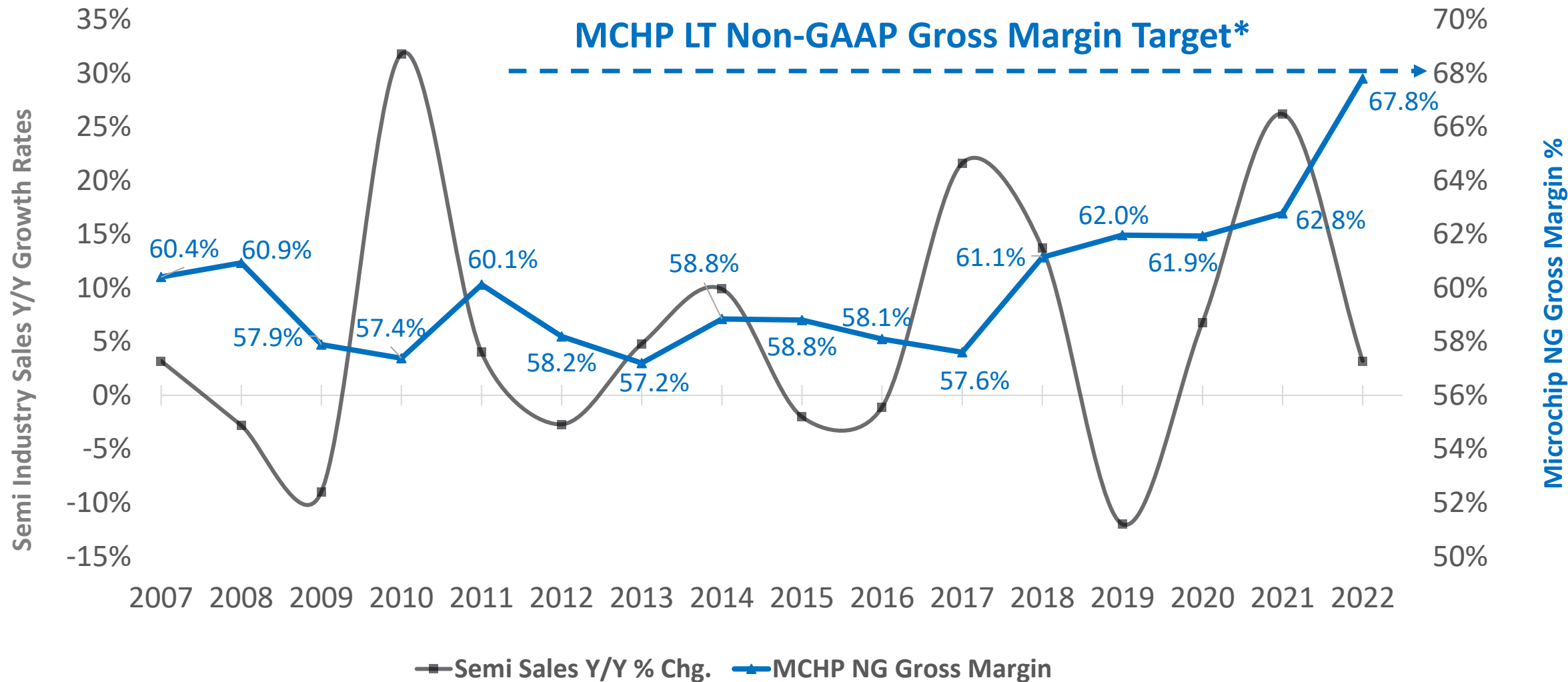

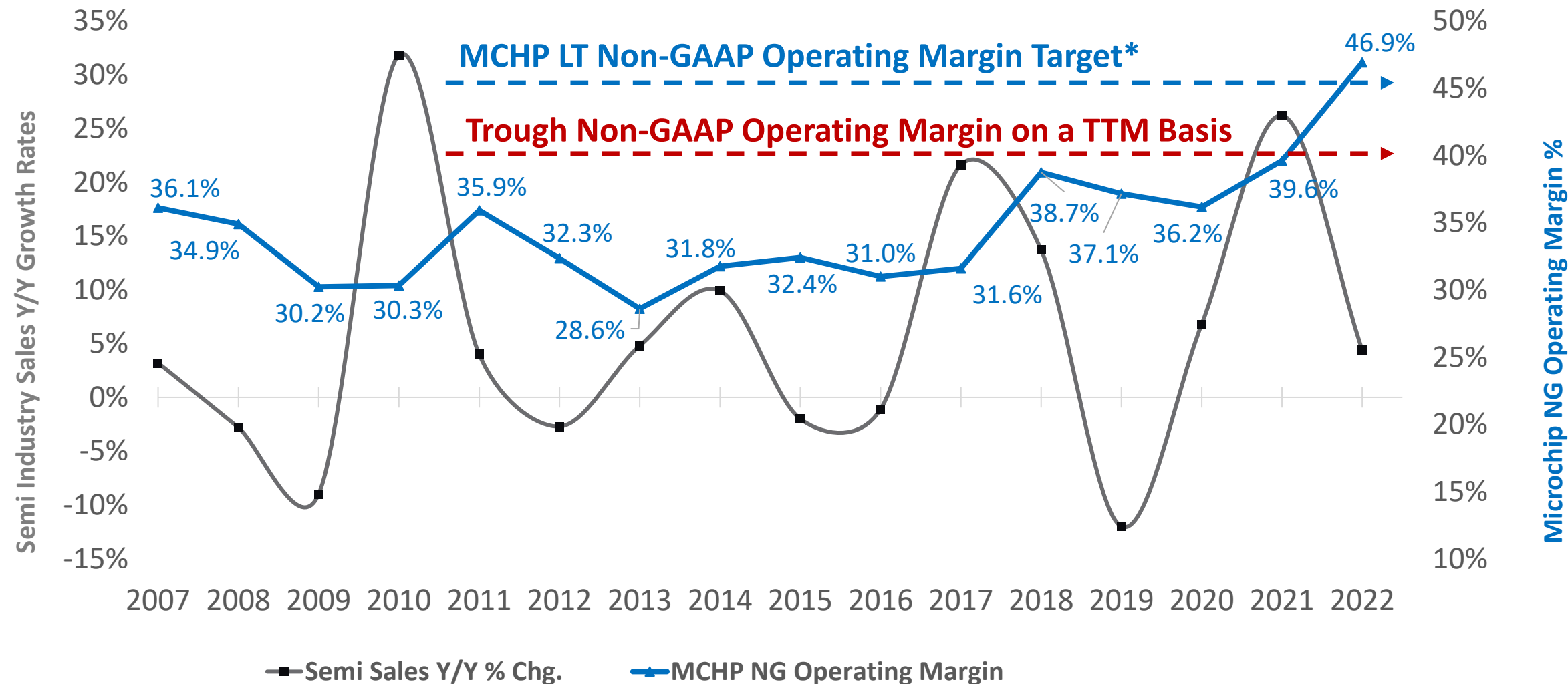
