Avianca SECOND QUARTER 2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- Avianca achieved robust second quarter 2023 results in a seasonally challenging quarter.
 - The Company generated \$271.3 million in EBITDAR with a 24.3% margin; \$88.7 million ahead of Business Plan. In addition, Net Income was \$15.4 million.
 - Passenger CASK ex-fuel was \$3.9 cents during second quarter 2023, as compared to prior guidance of \$3.8 cents. Avianca's Passenger CASK ex-fuel guidance was updated to a range of \$3.7 cents to \$3.8 cents by the fourth quarter 2023, as compared to prior guidance of \$3.4 cents, due to COP/USD exchange rates, inflation and temporary fleet expenses. The Group remains committed to achieving a best-in-class cost structure and continues executing on its Business Plan.
 - The Company's cash balance increased by \$84.8 million, reaching a total of \$1,013.2 million at June 30, 2023.
 - Avianca further deleveraged during second quarter 2023, as Net Debt to LTM EBITDAR fell to 3.2x.
- LifeMiles cash EBITDA increased 11% year on year. Cargo revenues and margins were ahead of Business Plan projections, though lower compared to last year.
- Abra: We are closely working with GOL on capturing synergies and will provide guidance later on.

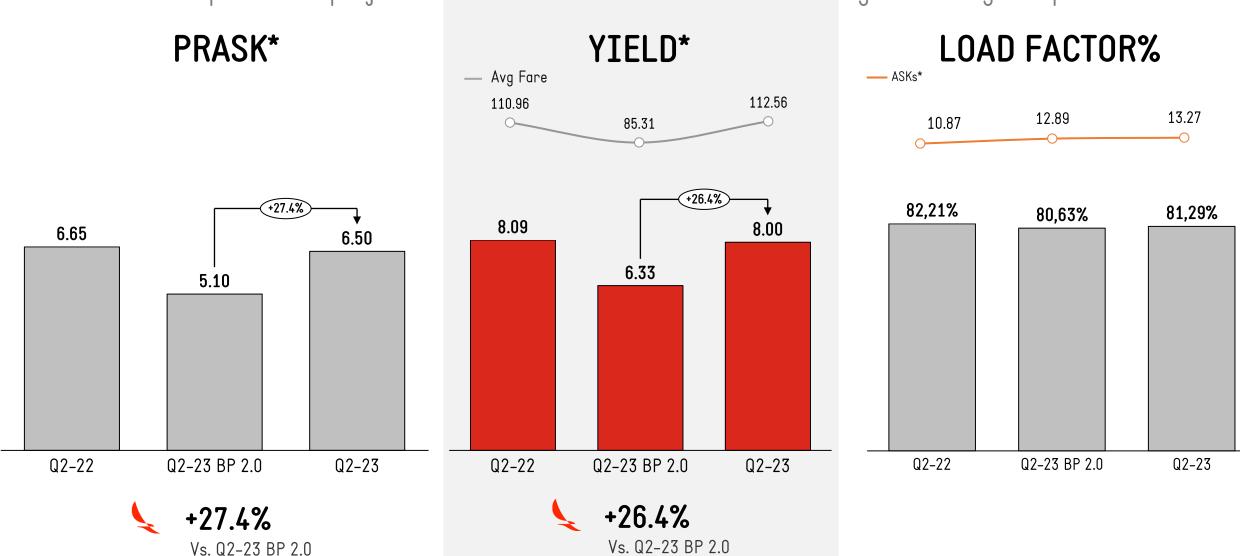


NB Densification 100%

104 narrowbody aircraft were reconfigured with a brand-new cabin, increasing capacity by an additional 20% and ensuring a standardized product.

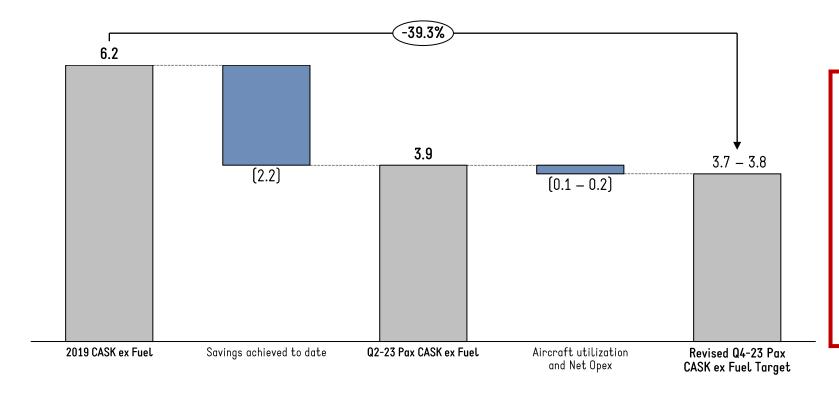
Avianca UNIT METRICS

Avianca COST STRUCTURE

Avianca ended Q2-2023 with a Pax CASK ex-fuel of 3.9 cents, and has revised its PAX CASK ex fuel guidance to a range of 3.7 cents to 3.8 cents by the fourth quarter 2023, from prior guidance of 3.4 cents. The Group remains committed to achieving a best-in-class cost structure and continues executing on its Business Plan



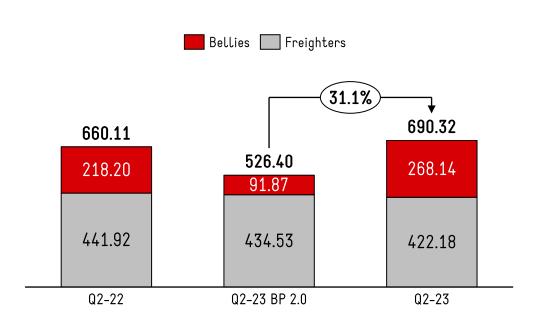
Revised Q4-23 Pax Cask ex Fuel target has increased due to:

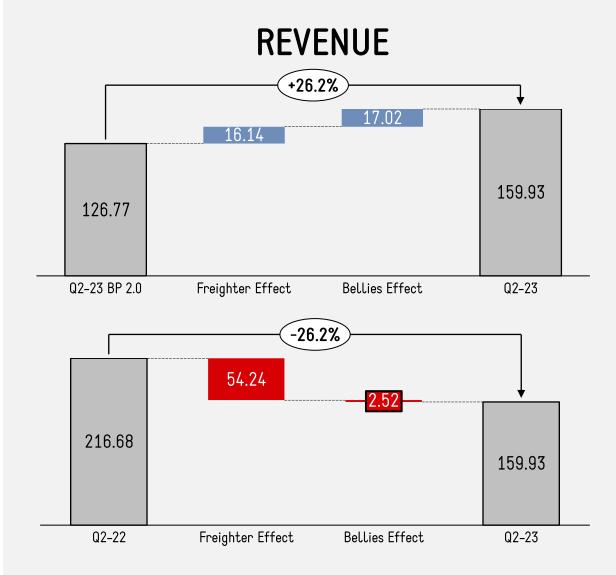
- Higher dollar value of COP expenses as the peso strenghtened relative to the US dollar.
- Rising inflationary pressure on most of AGIL's operational expenses, primarily on salaries.
- Temporary fleet costs related to incremental wet leases and incremental PBH due to WB fleet delays.
- Changes in domestic/international route mix that led to increased airport fees and crew expenses.

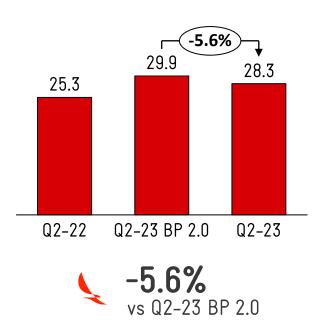






LifeMiles continued to generate an important Cash EBITDA contribution to the Group.

LM CASH EBITDA TO AGIL¹



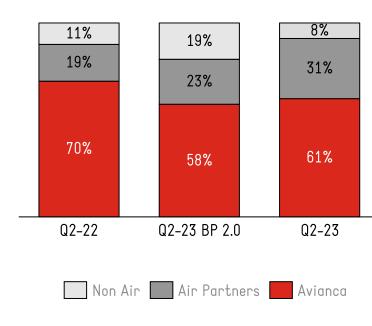
 Decreased third-party Gross Billings, partially offset by decreased non-air redemptions and SG&A.

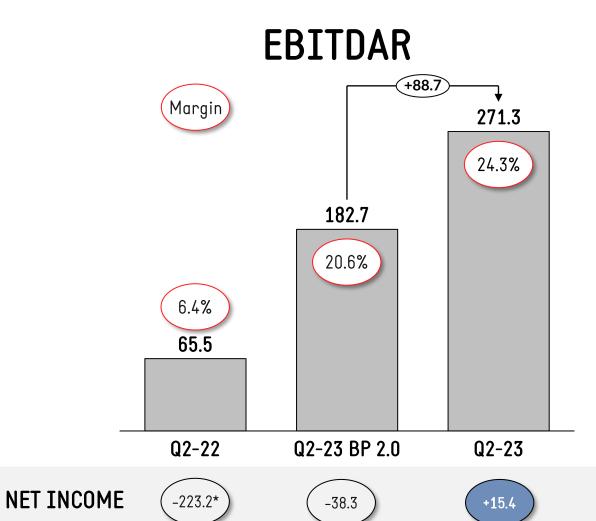
 Miles redeemed in Air Partners (noncompeting routes) have increased significantly relative to last year due to increased miles sales in North America

The Company again delivered robust financial results as EBITDAR reached \$271.3 million, with a 24.3% EBITDAR margin.

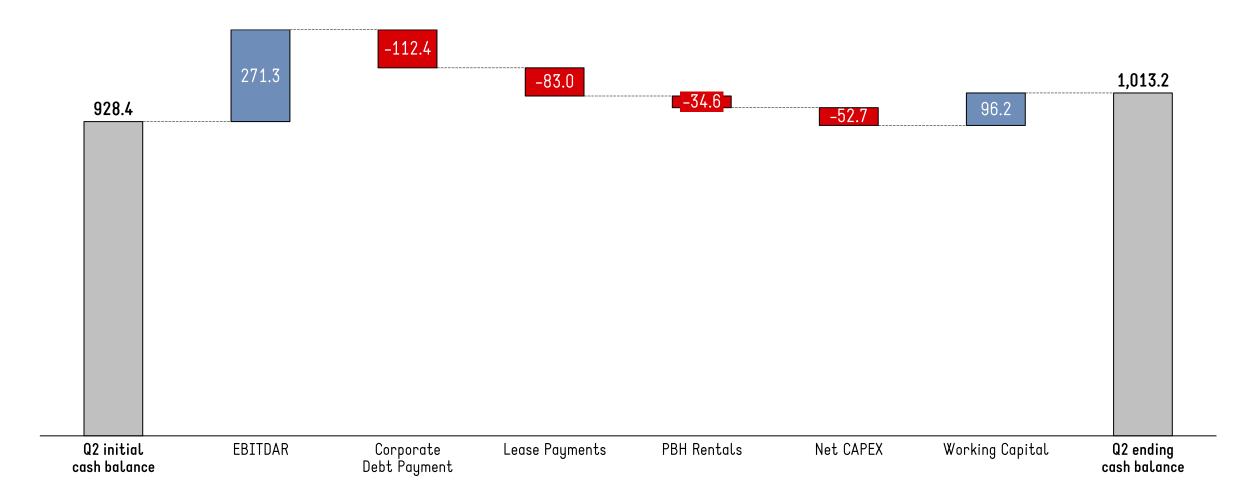


BP 2.0: Business Plan projections.

Avianca CASH FLOW

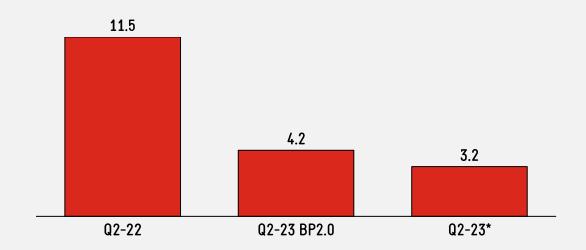
Cash generation for the period reached \$84.8 million, reaching a solid \$1,013.2 million cash balance at June 30, 2023.



Strong financial results led to a significant deleverage: Net Debt/LTM EBITDAR fell to 3.2x by quarter's end.
