BIOSIG SEES INCREASED CASE VOLUME

We have seen an increased case volume from our expanding base of medical centers using the PURE EP™ System, a non-invasive computerized technology that aims to drive procedural efficiency and efficacy in electrophysiology. We anticipate completing at least 1500 cases and growing our install base to 20 by the end of 2021.

We are currently conducting patient cases in 9 medical centers across the country including Texas Cardiac Arrhythmia Institute at St. David's Medical Center in Austin, TX, Mayo Clinic Florida Campus and the University of Pennsylvania.



This case growth, combined with the consistently positive customer feedback, positions us well to deliver on our target.

The PURE EP™ System elevates the standard of care in electrophysiology through enhanced signal acquisition, digital signal processing, and analysis. The PURE EP™ System is powered by a unique hardware architecture allowing the full range of cardiac analog signals to be acquired in a raw, streamlined, unfiltered format. This is then converted into a digital modality powered by advanced signal processing software for unlimited real time data analysis.

Our Senior Manager of Training and Education, Susan Shen, initially laid the groundwork for the program simply as a means to train all the new CAMs joining BioSig in early 2020.
