The Bergkamen facility has adopted measures to reduce the loss of polyamide granules used for printing ink resins and hot melt adhesives. Besides recycling waste pellets and adopting production and cleaning procedures to limit loss, the site has also started using special octabin cardboard packaging to protect finished products from piercing during transport and at customer sites.

**1959:** Schering company acquired the facility from Chemische Werke Bergkamen, as well as the production license for polyamides from General Mills

**1960:** Started amine and polyamidoamine hardener production

**1971**: Started epoxy resins production as a joint venture with Solvay Duromer GmbH

**1992**: Witco acquired Schering resin and additives business

**1998**: Ciba Specialty Chemicals acquired the resin business from Witco

**2000**: Vantico emerged from a spin-off of Ciba Specialty Chemicals

2003: Huntsman Corp acquired Vantico

2004: Closure of the epoxy resin production

2005: Epoxy board production started for tooling

2014: Sold Epoxy board production
