

Suzanne McCarron Named as President of ExxonMobil Foundation

McCarron, General Manager, Public and Government Affairs, has been named President of the ExxonMobil Foundation. She replaces Gerald W. McCarron's appointment will be effective May 31, 2010. In addition to her new role, she will continue to serve in her position as General Manager, Public and Government Affairs, in which she has responsibility for public and government affairs activities for the corporation's global functional Upstream, Downstream and Chemical businesses, as well as ExxonMobil's corporate citizenship programs.
