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Doubling the size of the plant in Mexico

The investment plan will initially open with the amount of 4.5 million Euros, which is expected to double early in 2012, and will reach 30 million by the time the plant has been completed."

The facility is situated on an 40,000 m² lot, 20,000 m² of which will be covered upon completion of the project. It will employ 250 people and will be capable of supplying enough glass containers, ampoules, vials and cartridges for pharmaceutical use to satisfy the demand of not only the North American market but also the South and Central American markets as well.
