We present non-GAAP financial information to enable investors to see TTM through the eyes of management and to provide better insight into our ongoing financial performance.

A material limitation associated with the use of the above non-GAAP financial measures is that they have no standardized measurement prescribed by GAAP and may not be comparable to similar non-GAAP financial measures used by other companies. ## Key Messages from Q3 2023 Earnings Report and Call

- Revenue of \$572.6M in line with guidance of \$550-\$590M
- GAAP EPS of (\$0.36), inclusive of a goodwill impairment charge of \$44.1 million
- Non-GAAP EPS of \$0.43 well above the guided range of \$0.25-\$0.31
- Cash flow from operations of \$58.9 million
- Repurchased 1 million shares of common stock for \$14.6 million at an average price of \$14.33 per share
- Cash balance of \$408.3M. Net leverage defined as net debt divided by last twelve months of EBITDA at 1.5x.
- Expect Q4 revenues of \$550 to \$590M and non-GAAP EPS of \$0.34 to \$0.40
